Application Instructions

Each applicant must submit a complete application package postmarked by the application deadline. The package must include the following:

1. A completed application form.
2. Attach a brief, yet complete, essay indicating educational objectives, future plans of study, professional activities, how you have promoted the profession and your financial status and degree of need.
3. Attach at least one letter of recommendation from a faculty member familiar with the students work.
4. Attach a complete and official transcript through May of the year prior to when the award will be presented.

Incomplete, improperly completed and late applications will be discarded. Valid applications must be postmarked no later than December 7th . It is the obligation of the applicant to ensure that applications be postmarked by December 7th

Eligibility

Currently enrolled in an accredited surveying course baccalaureate program or currently enrolled in an associate degree program in surveying or survey engineering with the intent to attend an accredited surveying course baccalaureate program or to pursue a career in the Land Surveying profession.
